As universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the machine and are a lot less at risk to damage. These buckets are even 50% deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional room makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

## Quick-Tach Buckets

The Quick-Tach is able to dump objects approximately 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
